This is your opportunity to register and join the second cohort of the International Leadership and Management Programme - a unique, quality, relevant learning experience that benefits you personally and your school.

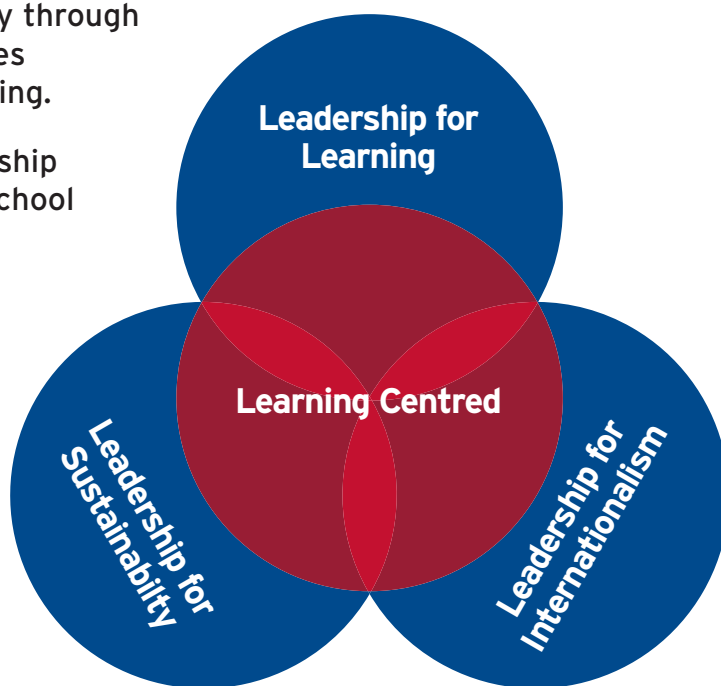
The International Leadership and Management Programme is a school-based, practitioner programme, designed to impact both directly and indirectly on improved student learning in your school.
